Do you know a foster child who is struggling in their current school? Florida's foster children deserve a quality education and Step Up For Students believes in providing Florida's children with a quality education.

If the foster child is entering Kindergarten through 12th grade and meets the income eligibility guidelines, he or she would qualify for a private school scholarship worth up to \$3,950 or a \$500 transportation scholarship to attend an out-of-district public school.



A Florida Foster Care Child Qualifies For a Private School Scholarship If:

1. The student is currently placed in foster care or was in foster care during the 2007-2008 school year
2. Their individual foster care income does not exceed **\$19,240**

Apply today! Over 10,000 new scholarships are available for the 2008-2009 school year. If the foster child meets the qualifying guidelines, he or she may be eligible for a scholarship worth up to \$3,950. Once approved, the scholarship can be used at over **1,000 private schools** in Florida.
